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### ACTIVITIES

We will run an activity station by rack so that all activities are age specific and will be approximately 45 minutes in duration. Activities will include crafts, family games, scout games, rank achievements (Den time), guided hikes, and a bonfire with closing ceremonies.

### ACCOMMODATIONS

We will be staying at the Mimsi and Shawnee campsites at the Rodney Scout Reservation. These campsites each have a bunkhouse with kitchen facilities and plenty of space to set up tents. There are no private sleeping quarters available. In order to abide by BSA policies, 1 bunkhouse will be available for lady campers and 1 bunkhouse will be available for gentlemen campers. Restroom facilities are available in shower houses near our campsites.

### MEALS

Pack 2 will provide Saturday night dinner and Sunday morning breakfast bottled water, juice, milk, coffee and tea. **NO** sodas will be available. Everyone is asked to pack a lunch for Saturday. We will be eating wholesome meals and will avoid hotdogs and hamburgers.

### RESTRICTIONS

**NO** firearms or air guns are permitted in camp. **NO** sheath knives are permitted in camp. **NO** fireworks are permitted in camp. **NO** alcohol is permitted in camp. **NO** illegal and unlabeled drugs are permitted in camp. The use of tobacco products in the presence of campers is strictly forbidden.

**All BSA policies for “Pack Overnights” as stated in the Guide to Safe Scouting will be enforced on the camping trip.**
